



# **LPESSN Football League Team Sportsmanship Point.**

A team each week will receive a point for showing sportsman like behaviour. This is something the London PE and School Sports Network have introduced to show children, staff and spectators that it is important to respect the decisions made throughout the games played.

## **How It Works:**

- A point a week will be awarded to a team that shows sportsman like behaviour. This includes teachers on the side-line and also parents and carers associated with the school. A point will not be awarded to a team that cannot show sportsmanship throughout their game.
- Each week the LPESSN team will pick a team who they think deserves the point, the boys and girls points will be separate. The boy's team will get 1 point and the girl's team will get 1 point.
- You **will not** be told on the day, the point will be announced through email

## **What Is The Point Awarded For?**

- Players showing respect to the referee
- Players being able to demonstrate a good attitude to opponents
- Players shaking hands after a game
- Teachers encouraging students to respect the decisions of the referee
- Spectators respecting all decisions given
- Teachers showing respect to other schools
- Arriving on time to play fixtures
