



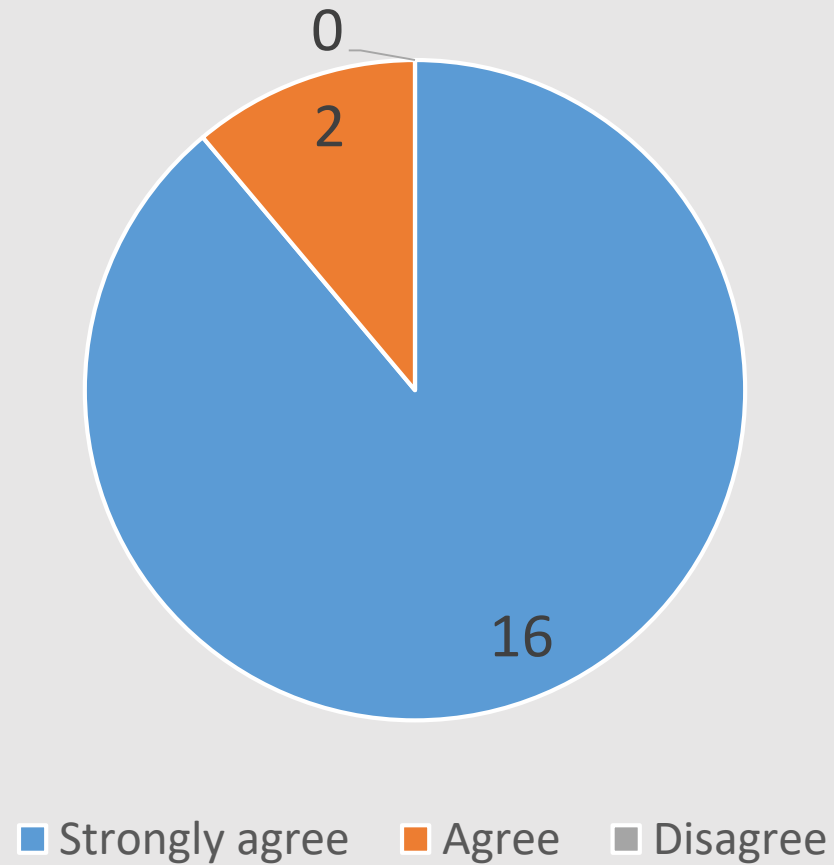

Maths Pupil Voice February 2019

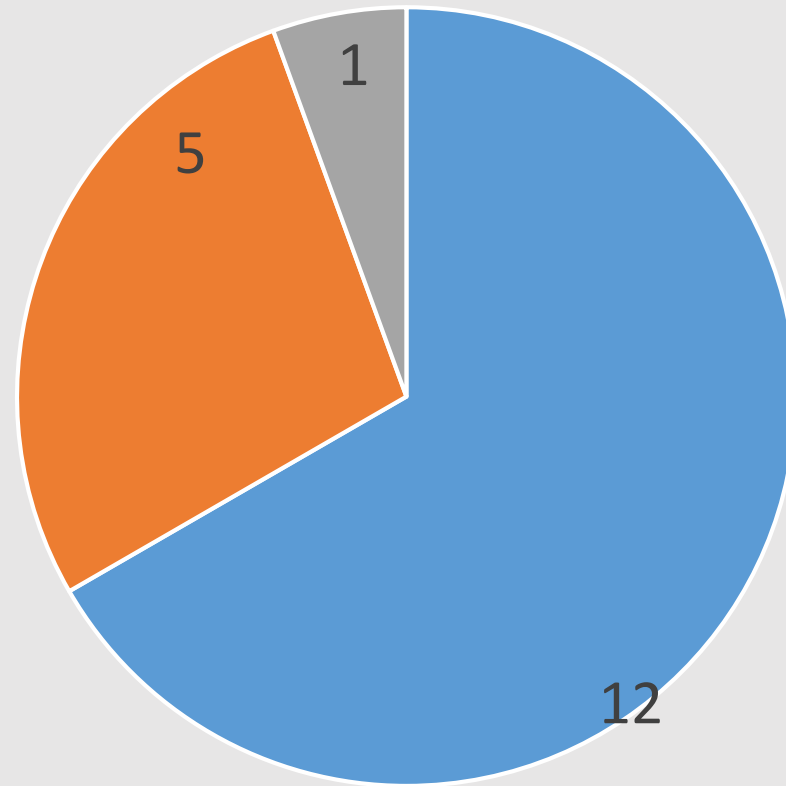
The maths leader asked 18 children in key stages 1 and 2 their views on the school. The children were a mixture of boys and girls and pupil premium and non pupil premium.

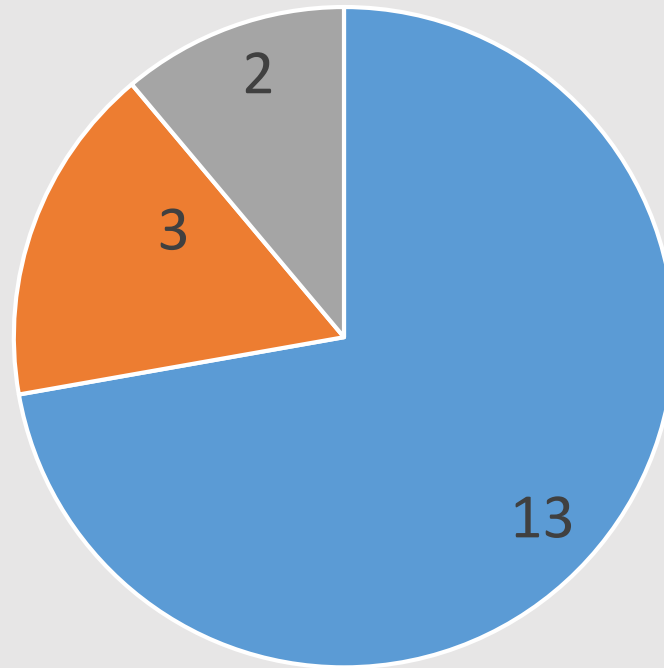


My maths target is important



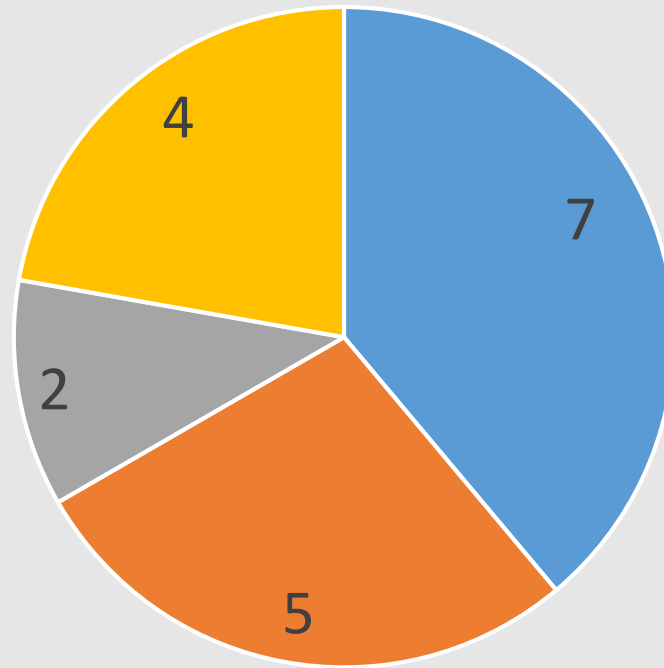

Reasoning is useful



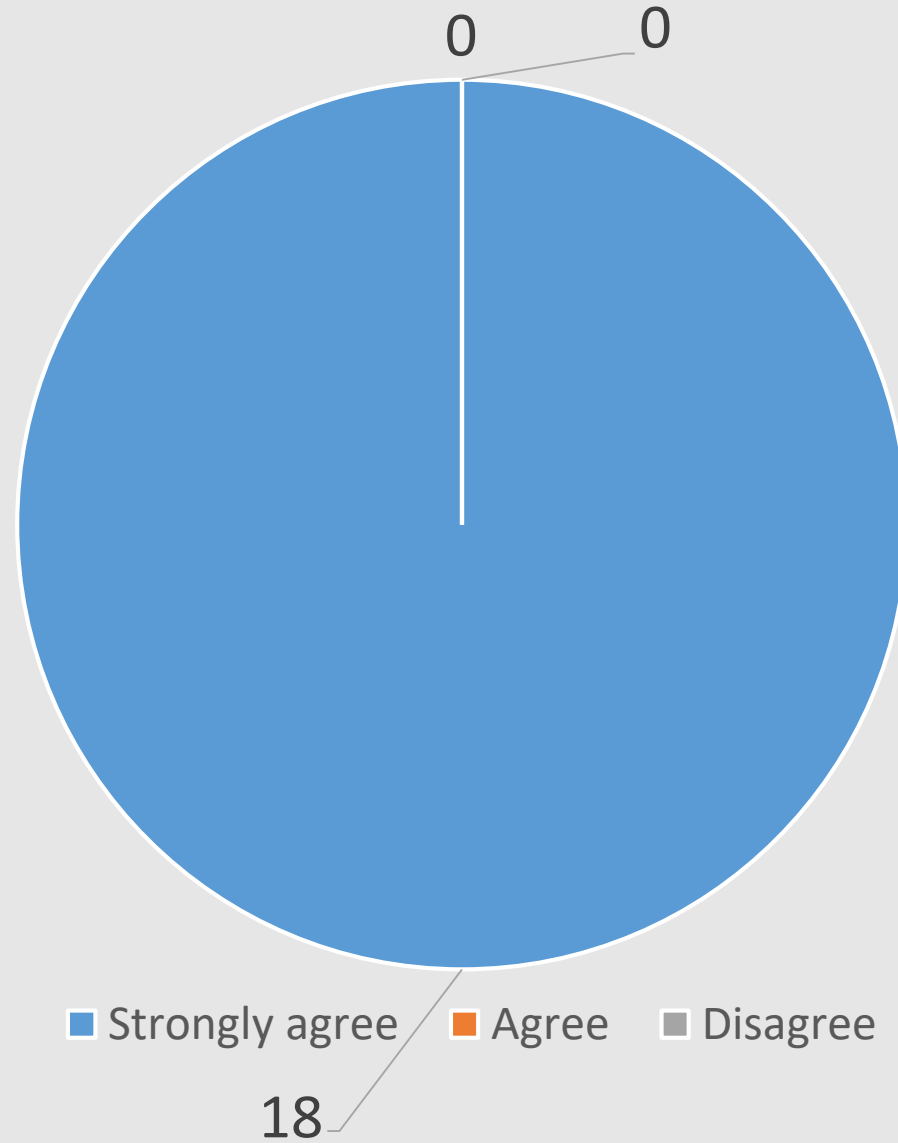

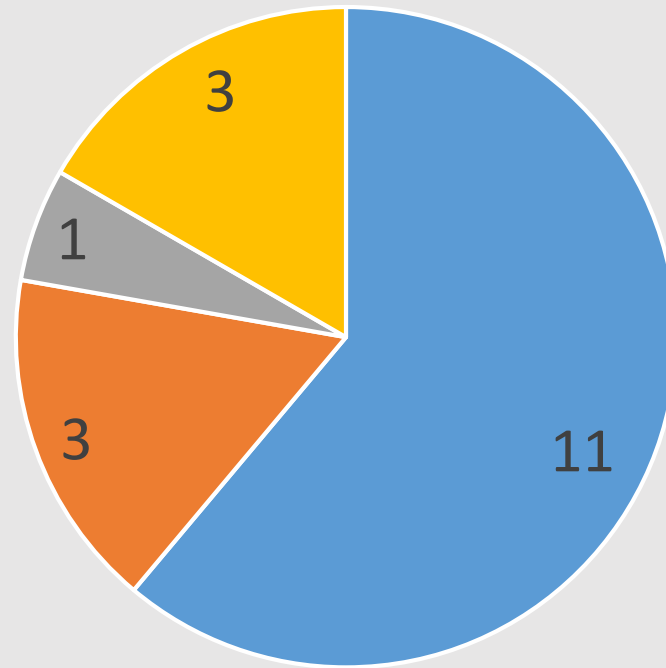

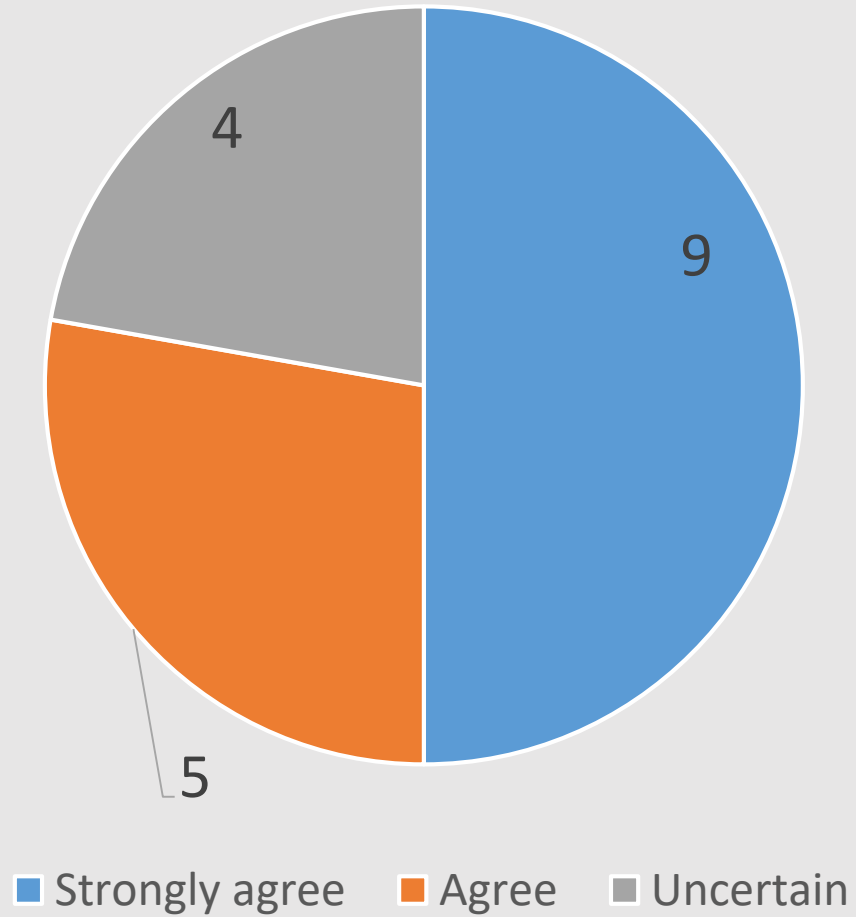

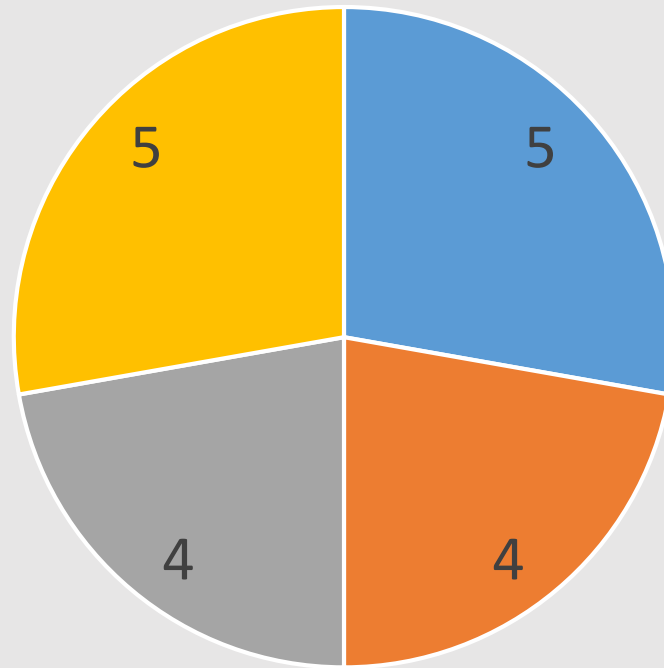

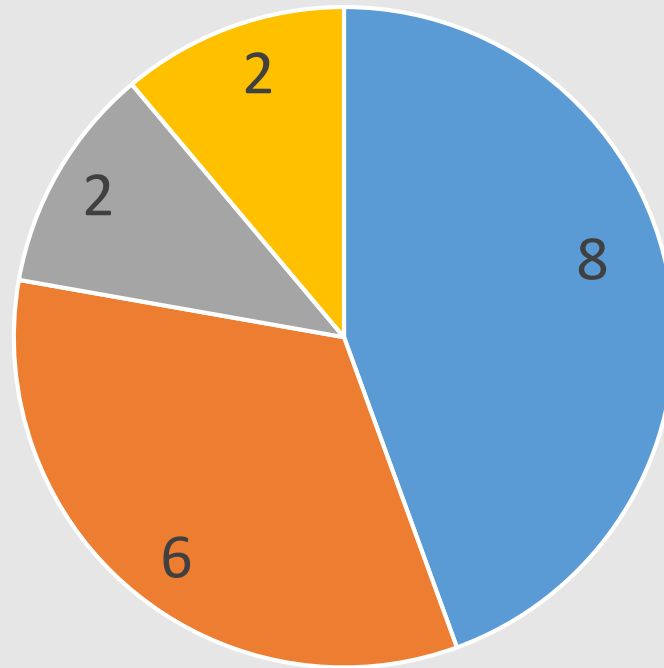

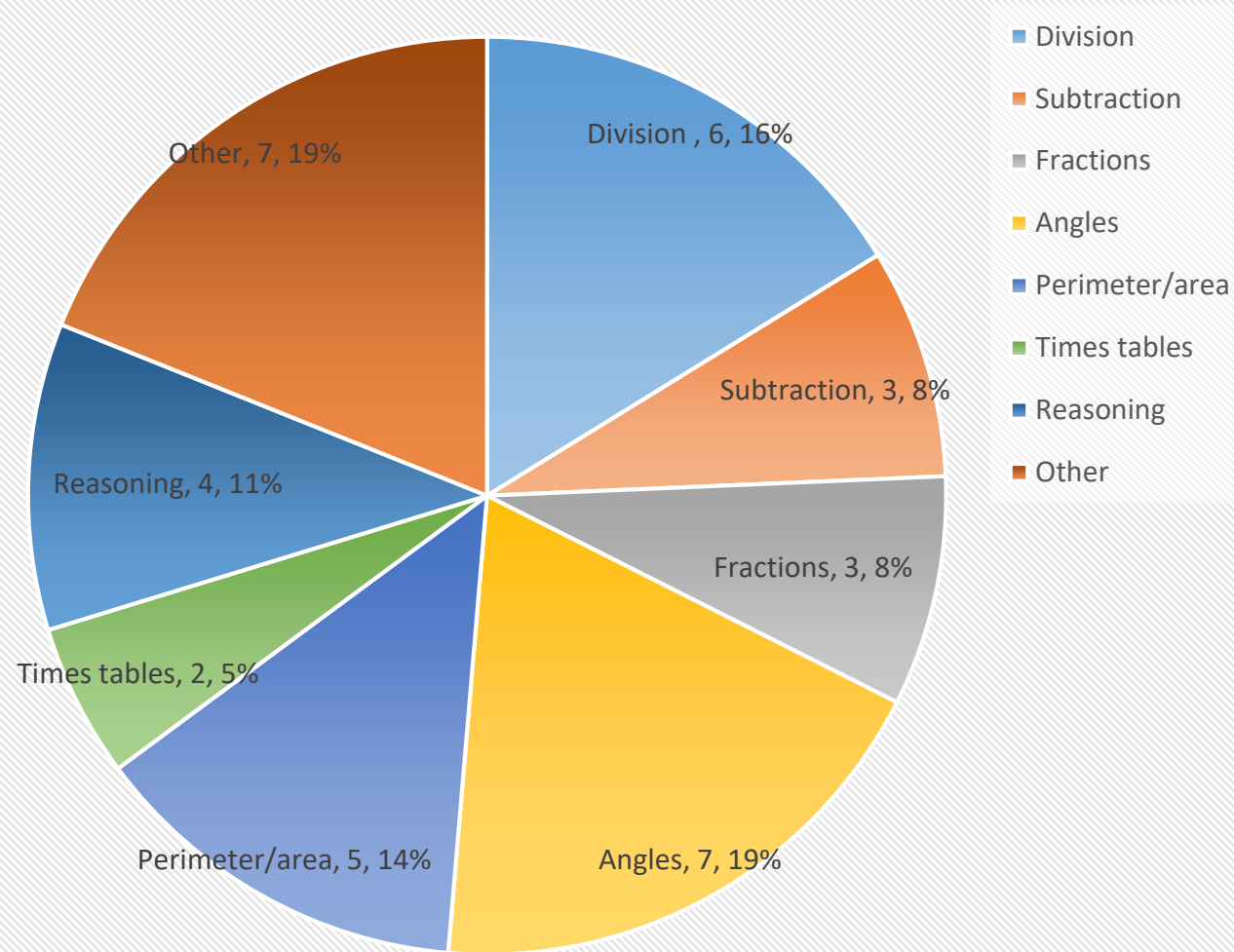
