



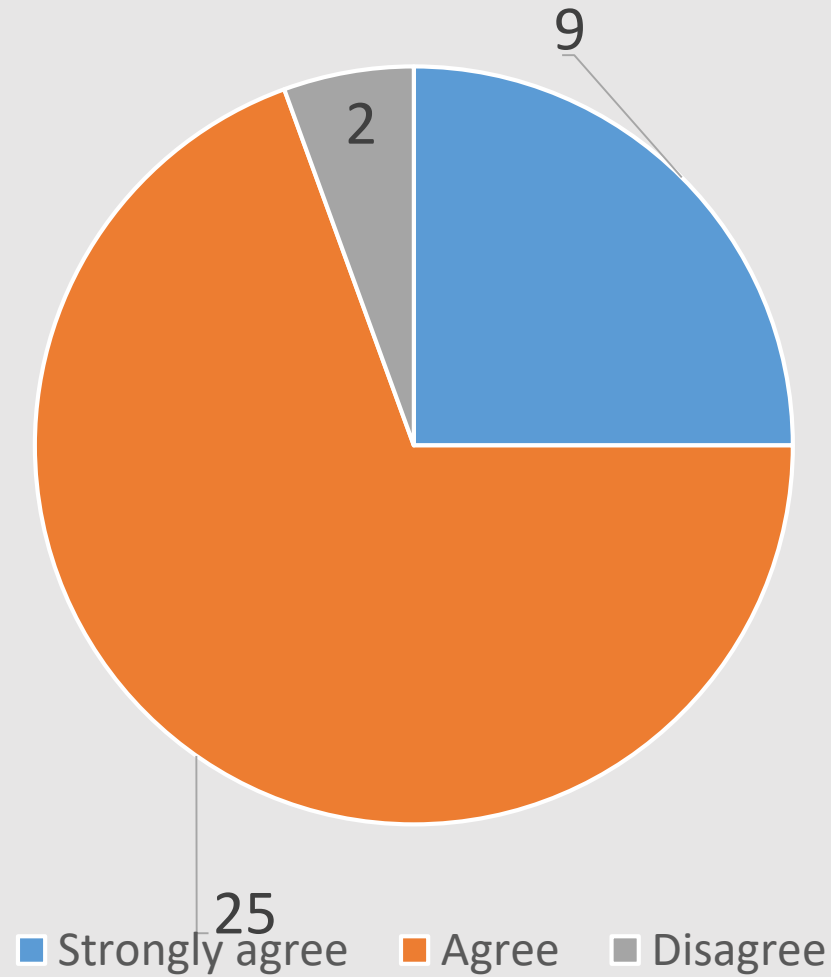

Behaviour Pupil Voice March 2019

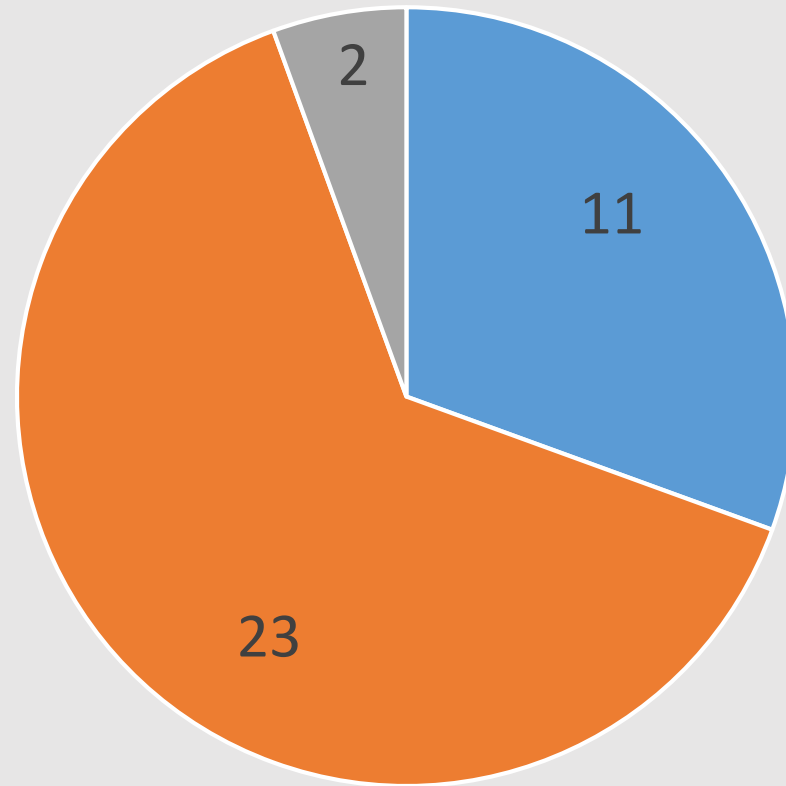

Behaviour at Townsend is good

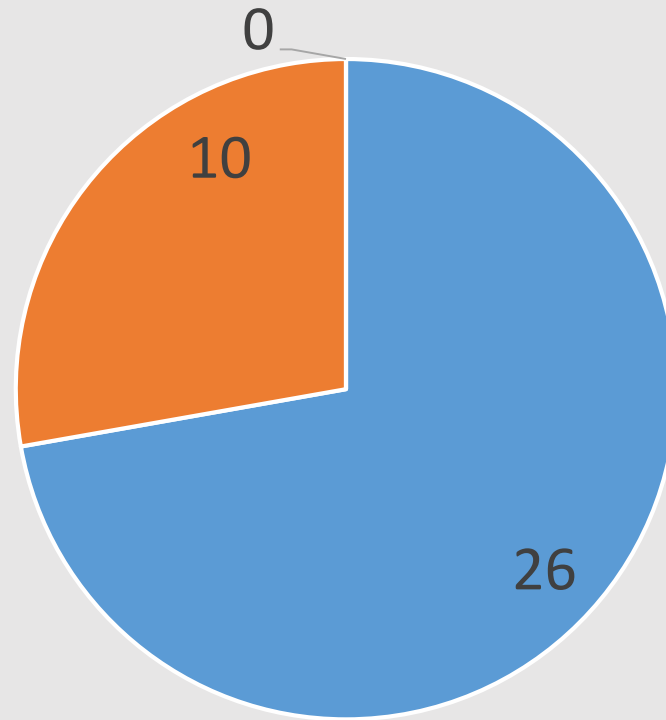


Incidents are dealt with well



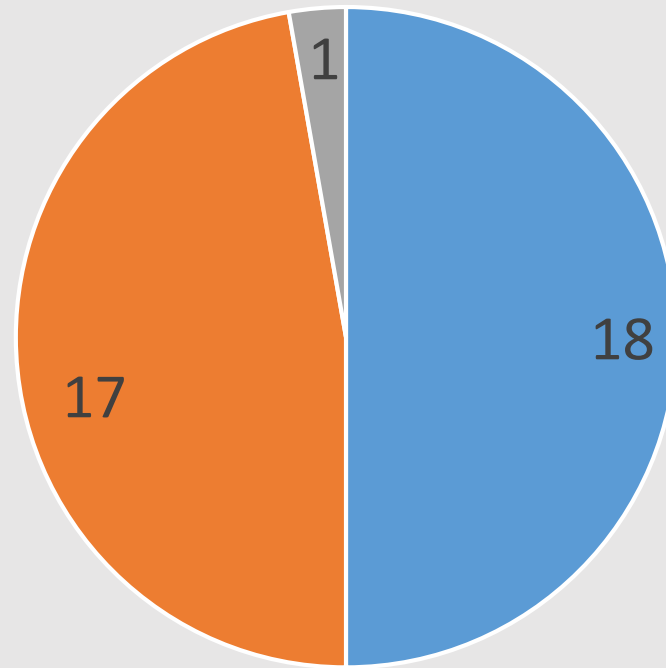

I feel safe at school



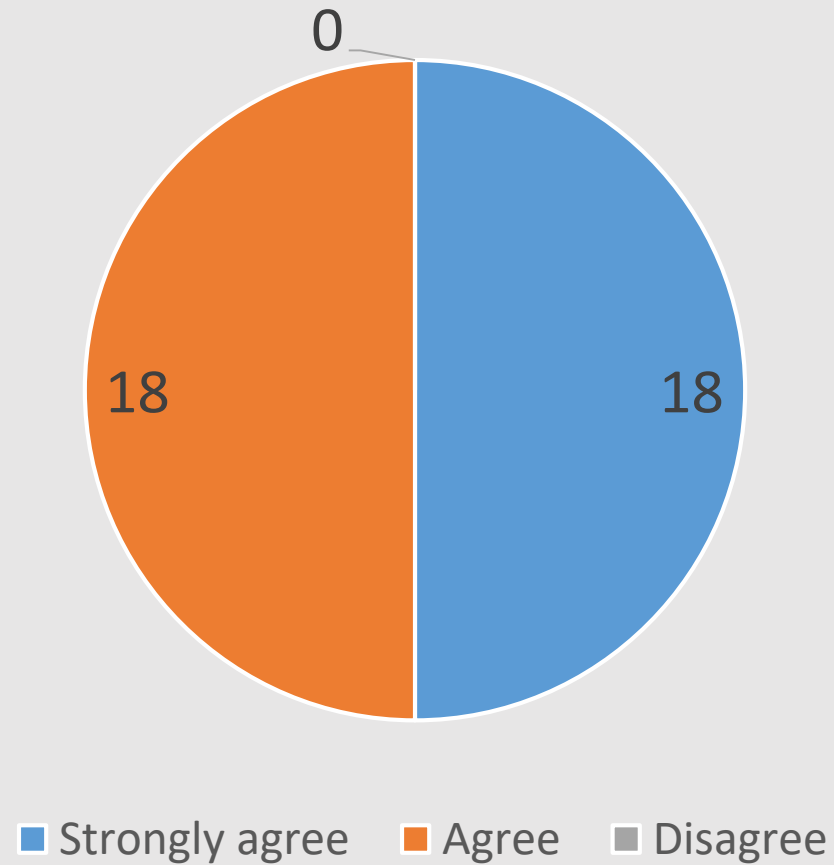

My school is a happy and caring place

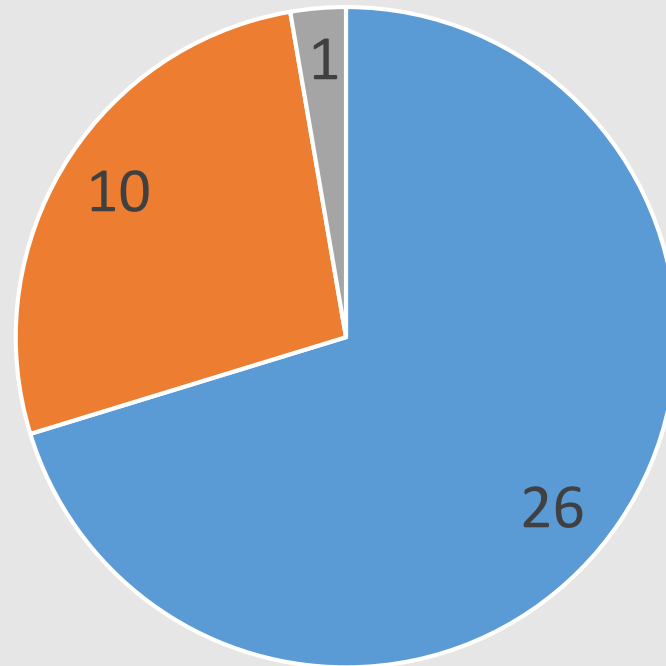

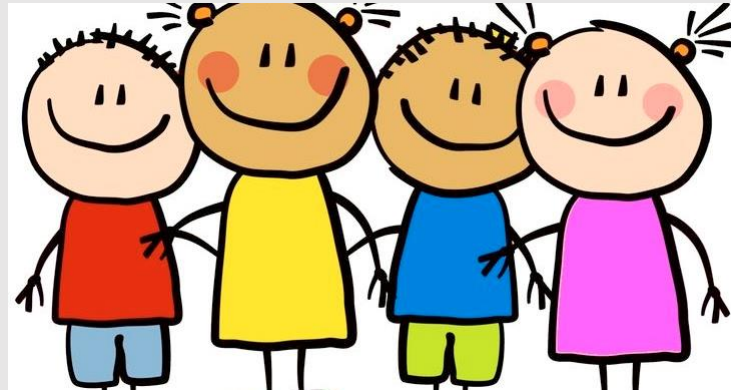
They tell us what we're doing wrong and how it will affect other pupils.
