Hello Nursery,

I hope you've all had a lovely Easter and are all adjusting to the new way of learning by now. Here are today's activities (see activity sheet below). **Please notice there is a recommended time each activity should take. Please do not go over this time.** Also do take a break between the activities rather than trying to complete one after the other.

(10 mins) Maths

(10 mins) Reading

Challenges – There are challenge in the daily activities. These are more challenging than the suggested activities, however, please note that they are optional activities.

Literacy: Handa's Surprise

1. Can you remember any of the animals that Handa saw on her walk?
Listen to the story Handa's Surprise on YouTube again to find out.

As you listen to the story, name the animals and help your parent to write a list. Parents to model writing for the children.

Maths: Shapes

1. Listen to the shape song.

2. Spend some time looking at the shape picture below. What shapes can you see?

Challenge: Parents – model finding the sides. How many sides does it have?
Let your child join in with finding and counting the sides on another shape.

Name writing (optional)

Parents – model writing your child's name (one letter at a time, talk about the formation of the letters). After you have written each letter, encourage your child to write the same letter.

Play

Spend some time playing together. Talk about what your child is doing, comment on their play and join in with they are doing.



Expressive Art and Design

Think about the animals in the story Handa's Surprise. Which animal was your favourite? Why?

Can you draw a picture of your favourite animal?

Challenge: Write a label for the animal that you have drawn. Focus on the initial sounds.

Help for parents: Find out what they have drawn e.g. a monkey. Encourage them to think about what sound the word starts with (e.g Monkey starts with an 'm'. Once they have identified the initial sound, use the mat below. Show them two options -m and s. Which one is m? encourage them to use the pictures on the sound mat to help them. (This is just an example)

Reading: Read daily with your child. You could read books that you have at home or you could have a look at some of the online reading materials
