Day 3: Make tickets & a poster

Now you have chosen what Movie or Story you are going to have for your special time together you can make a poster to stick up to remind everyone what they are going to watch and when it is happening. You can draw pictures of the characters in the story or movie that you are going to watch to add onto your poster. You can also make tickets to give to everyone with their names on and what seat or cushion number they are going to sit on

Challenge: You could write each person an invitation to the special movie or story time and make envelopes to put your invitations in. You could make them like cards and draw pictures on the front.

Phonics

Recap Phase 3 sound sh

1. Play Phonics Pop [click here](#), selecting sh and two other sounds. Can you find the bubbles with the sh sound?
2. Read and draw: sound out the words below (look out for the sh sound!) and draw a picture for each word:

fish, sheep, shop

- 3: find things in your house with the sh sound. Example: shampoo, sheets, shoe, shell, etc.

Challenge: write a list of the things that you found.

Maths

Find the number cards you were given – numbers 1 to 20.

1. Can you put them in order 1 to 20.
2. Now ask an adult to take one number away from your line of numbers. Can you work out which one is missing.
3. Can you write that number which is missing.
4. Now ask your adult to take away a different number. Did you work out which one was missing?
5. Using your fingers and toes make some teen numbers. See if your adult can work out which teen number you are making. They need to show you the correct card.

Challenge: can you write some of the teen numbers? Eg. if you know how to write six just add ten and you have written sixteen. Try it with some other numbers.
