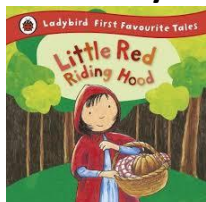
Challenges – If you find some of the suggested activities quite easy make sure you do the challenge activities each day.

Count to 20 song

3. Pick the top card
4. Say the number name

1. Click on 'play free resources'

6. Click through 'Next' to 'Phase 3'
7. Select +j and +v

9. Can you find anything in your house that begins with j and v? Can you sound out any of those words?

Challenge: Can you make a list of all the words you can think of beginning with j and get your adult to make a list of all the words they can think of beginning with v. Who got the most?

Expressive Art and Design
