(10 mins) Reading

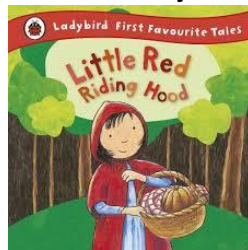

These are activities for you to try and if you like them take as long as you wish.

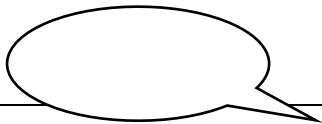
Literacy



Little Red Riding Hood

1. Watch the story of Little Red Riding Hood [click here](#)
2. What did Little Red Riding Hood say to the wolf?
3. How do you think Little Red Riding Hood felt when she saw grandma?
4. Draw a picture of each character in the story.

Challenge: Cut out the pictures of your characters and stick them onto a paper where there is space for you to write in a speech bubble what they say. Use the speech bubbles to write a sentence for each of the characters. Think about what has happened and how they might be feeling.

Recap Phase 3 sounds w and x

1. Click on 'play free resources'
2. Click on 'Buried Treasure.'
3. Click through 'Next' to 'Phase 3' & select +w and +x
4. PLAY!
5. Can you find anything in your house that begins with w and x?
6. Can you sound out any of those words?

Challenge: You make a list of all the things beginning with w and get your adult to make a list with thing with x in eg. box. Who has got the most?

Maths

1. Watch Number blocks song '11'

for a Ten Frame ICT game.
3. Use the 1-10 number cards from the activity pack you got from school or make some more number cards.
4. Put the number cards face down in a pile then pick the top card, say the number name
5. Drag the matching number of counters on to the ten frame

Challenge: What would one more than the number be? How could you show it on the ten frame? (If you do not have access to a computer/tablet then you could draw a ten frame like the one below and use objects from around the house to put in each square.



Extra Challenge: Use number cards to 20 and use two tens frames on the game. Look on the right of the word 'clear' on the ICT game you can change the setting to have two tens frames.
