Maths

3. Play how many?

You will need counting objects (lego bricks, pasta twists, pebbles, grapes, beads) and your number cards 1 to 20.

Take a handful of your counting objects and estimate how many was in your handful. Place the number card that you have estimated next to your handful and then count to see how close your estimate was. Don't worry if your estimate was not exactly right you will improve if you keep practicing.

Challenge: When you count the objects after you have estimated try counting the objects in 2's.
