Welcome back! It's been a while since we were all together, but we're back in our safe bubbles to continue with our best learning – IN SCHOOL! Across the school, lessons have been planned to gradually build pupils stamina up, with a focus on interactive and interesting lessons.

In **English** this term we will be first focusing on writing and publishing our own books at differentiated levels.
