

Why is Doodle Maths important to do at home?

Step 2 'Little and often'

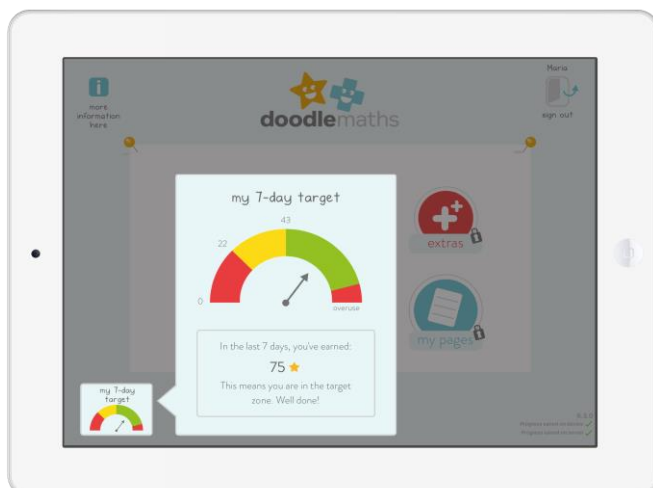


Use Doodle for 10 minutes a day on a laptop or iOS/Android device to catch up, get ahead or maintain learning.
